

Dear All,

Attention is drawn towards the Central Excise Manual-II chapter-7 para 6.2—Procedure for clearance from the factory or ware house.

- Director General of Foreign Trade has clarified that Exporters is entitled to receive 25 duly pre-signed CT forms for domestic procurement.
- The matter from Director General of Foreign Trade is attached for reference.

Sir/Madam,

1. DGFT had taken up the matter regarding non-issuance of CT form by excise authorities with Deptt of Revenue. It had been brought to their notice that after execution of B-1 Bond, units are entitled to receive 25 pre-signed CT forms for domestic procurement. However, the excise authorities provide only 1 CT form and next CT form is issued after utilization of the procurement, which results in delay and adds to the transaction cost of the exporters. It had been requested that CBEC may issue instructions to field authorities to provide 25 blank CT forms to the units after execution of B-1 Bond as per rules.

2. In response, DOR has informed this Directorate that the above instructions are contained in para 6.2 part II, Chapter 7 of Central Excise Manual and needs no reiteration. However, if specific details of a case of disregard of the parameters of these instructions are brought to their notice, they would examine it.

3. It is requested that this directorate may be informed of such cases, which may have been brought to your notice by your members for further taking up the matter with DOR.
